The venue:



Situated in the Paardeberg, between Malmesbury and Wellington (75 km / 1 hour from Cape Town) the venue is an old house on our working wine farm, with a big open sinkdak back stoep. Rustic to the core, the original farm house, from the turn of the 19th century, is set amid the vines and features a fully equipped kitchen, an undercover back porch with ambient lighting and a dancefloor under the stars. Expect chickens in the garden, lazy dogs in the most inconvenient place and peacock cries in the morning. The road to get here maybe a little wonky, but with the most spectacular views in the Swartland and no neighbours close enough to complain about your music, this is sure to be a celebration like no other. Ceremonies can be celebrated on the lawn in front of the wine cellar, under the archway by the farmhouse stoep, or in a unique clearing in 'die bloekom bos' under the maypole.



Venue fee for 2024 (Incl 15% VAT)

High Season (Sept - April) Up to 50 people R 44,000
Low season (May – August) Up to 50 people R 40,000
Additional people please add R 250pp (max 150)

Peak Season (15 December – 15 January) Up to 150 people R 70,000





Accommodation fee for 2024 (Incl 15% VAT)

*Please note that all the farm accommodation must be booked together with the venue. We can invoice your guests directly for this should you prefer.

Silo Honeymoon suite (1 bedroom)

R2400 per night

Complimentary night for the bridal couple on the night of the wedding

The Melkammer (1 bedroom) minimum 2 nights stay A few steps away from the venue, this recently converted self-catering cottage sleeps 2 adults (plus sofa bed suitable for 2 children)

R2600 per night

The Stables (2 bedroom) minimum 2 nights stay Luxurious converted farm stables, sleeps 4 adults (extra bed / cot for kids charged at R100p/n) R3600 per night

The Winemakers Cottage (2 bedroom) *minimum 2 nights stay*

Luxurious self-catering cottage, sleeps 4 adults (extra bed / cot for kids charged at R100p/n) R4400 per night

Koringhuis (3 bedroom) minimum 2 nights stay

Luxurious self-catering cottage, sleeps 6 adults (extra bed / cot for kids charged at R100p/n) R5600 per night

In addition to our farm cottages, there are a number of good local accommodation options close to us within a 15-25 minute drive. Shuttle services can be arranged.







The fee includes the following:

- Function venue: ceremony, pre-drinks & reception area. Use of lawn, stoep, cellar entrance and all outside areas (bos ceremonies an additional fee)
- Set-up and breakdown of outside & reception areas pre-event: *tables, chairs, bar etc the day before. This includes staff and table setting on the day of the event.*
- Staff: Set-up / breakdown staff, waiters (in-house catering only) cleaners, car park security guards and front of house manager for the duration of the event
- Wine: 1 bottle Secateurs chenin & 1 bottle Secateurs red blend per 10 guests
- Dancefloor area under vines and fairy lights
- Wine barrels (8) barrel braai's (3) fire baskets (2) wood
- Ambient lighting (fairy lights & bistro lights)
- Use of farm for photos
- Honeymoon accommodation in our Silo on the night of the wedding for the bride & groom
- Use of facilities until 01h30am. Please note that bar closes for last orders at 1am.
- The venue is available for set up from 8am the day before your event.
- Crockery: side/starter/main plates; tea/coffee cups/saucers; assorted milk jugs, platters & condiment bowls
- Cutlery: starter knife / fork / spoon; Dinner fork / Knife
- Glassware (breakages will be calculated post event): water glasses (assorted coloured or clear glass); wine /hi-ball / bubbly flutes / beer glasses & water jugs
- Bar: wooden bar counter, chest freezer; fridge; ice buckets / tongs; wine/ice coolers & galvanised baths; ice
- Furniture: 13 x long 10 seater wooden tables 20 x long wooden benches 50 x old wooden church chairs 150 x old wooden school chairs 1 x set vintage brown leather lounge suite
- Miscellaneous:
 - Fully equipped kitchen 2 bathrooms Assorted kelims /carpets Assorted tables, chairs, benches 3 large white garden umbrellas Yellow wood registry table & chairs Wood for fire buckets Hessian covers



EXCLUDING (but can be arranged):

- Catering: Please contact us for our farmstyle menu options. Outside catering can be arranged with preferred suppliers only. Please contact us for our recommendations.
- Additional staff: In the event of using an outside caterer then we will hire in professional waiters for service Quotes can be provided on request.
- A kitchen charge of R3000 will be added in the event of an outside caterer being used.
- DJ & sound equipment

- Services: In-house styling & farm décor: Can be arranged via Helena, Kick-Bang Omnific.
- All beverages: We are fully licenced and can run a cash bar for your guests. Wines are available from the farm at cellar door rates. We recommend a local Swartland bubbly, prices on request.
- Bar service: Bar staff are charged at R1500 per staff member (1 bar staff per 50 guests)
- Corkage fee: R90 (incl VAT) per bottle applies should you wish to bring in wine not supplied by the farm. Please note this is strictly by prior arrangement.
- Hiring of additional décor items
- Bos ceremonies under the maypole additional service fee of R6000 applies for the additional venue
- Shuttles to / from farm/ Bos or to other accommodation in area
- Linen Hire (tablecloths and serviettes)
- Tables, chairs, cutlery, crockery and glassware when exceeding 120 guests.
- Stretch tent to cover dance floor is included. A Marquee can be set up in other areas price on request.
- We have a generator that can power the cottages and venue in the event of loadshedding. Fuel is charged at R500/ hr.
- Tented accommodation: we can provide you with a quote for either luxurious glamping bell tents or very comfortable dome style tents with bedding for extra guest accommodation on the farm.
- Additional venue nights add-on: should you wish to extend your stay and make a weekend out of it, we can tailor make a weekend package for you. Please let us know.
- Staff gratuities / service charge: Our wonderful team of local farm workers work extra hard to make your special day most memorable. They do this with a smile on their faces and a dance in their step. A small token of your appreciation is always hugely appreciated if you feel they did a good job.

- 25 LED silver lanterns R30 each
- 30 Shepard's hooks R15 each

Terms & conditions:

All rates are subject to change without prior notice.

A 20% non-refundable deposit and signed contract is required to secure the reservation.

The balance is due in full 14 days prior to the function date at which time the final number of guests must be confirmed.

The client shall be responsible for any breakages, damages, shortages during the event.

A breakage fee of R5 000 (incl VAT) will be added to your invoice and will be fully/partially refunded depending on any breakages or damages caused to the venue by any member of the wedding party. The amount will be refunded back into the bank account supplied by the wedding couple 7 days after the function.

If paying via electronic banking, any bank charges incurred are at the expense of the client.

We request that no paper confetti is used on the farm. Alternatives could be fresh / dried flowers, bird seed or bubbles.

Should a radical shift in weather affect the arrangement of the function, the client remains responsible for any other extra cost.

AA Badenhorst Family Wines is a working farm with an unenclosed dam and farming/winemaking equipment. These may pose a danger for guests and parents must accompany their children at all times and take full responsibility for their safety. At an agreed fee, supervision can be arranged for children.
